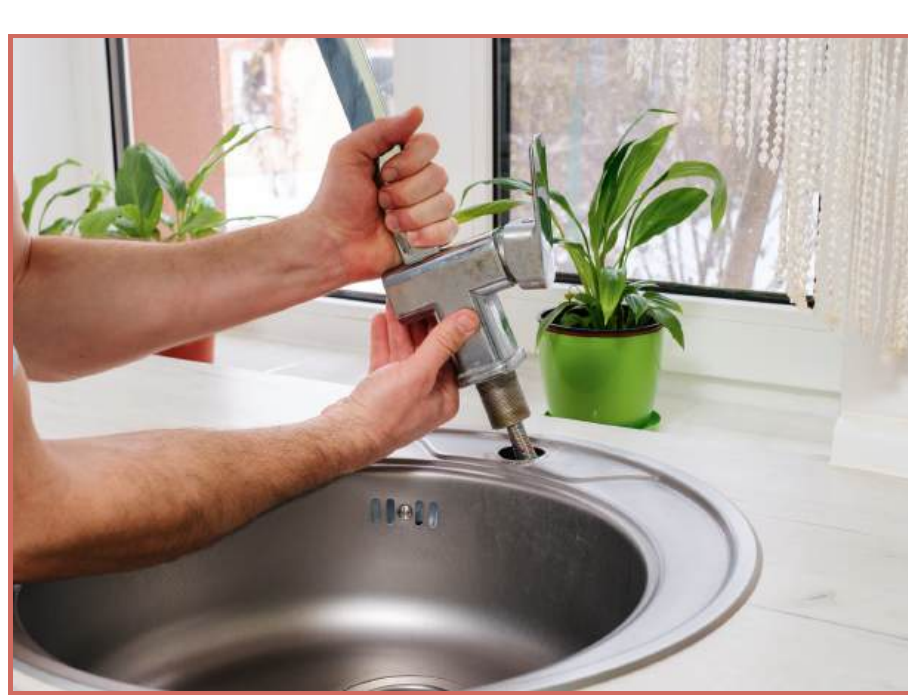
2. Door Dilemmas: Fix Squeaks, Drafts, and Security

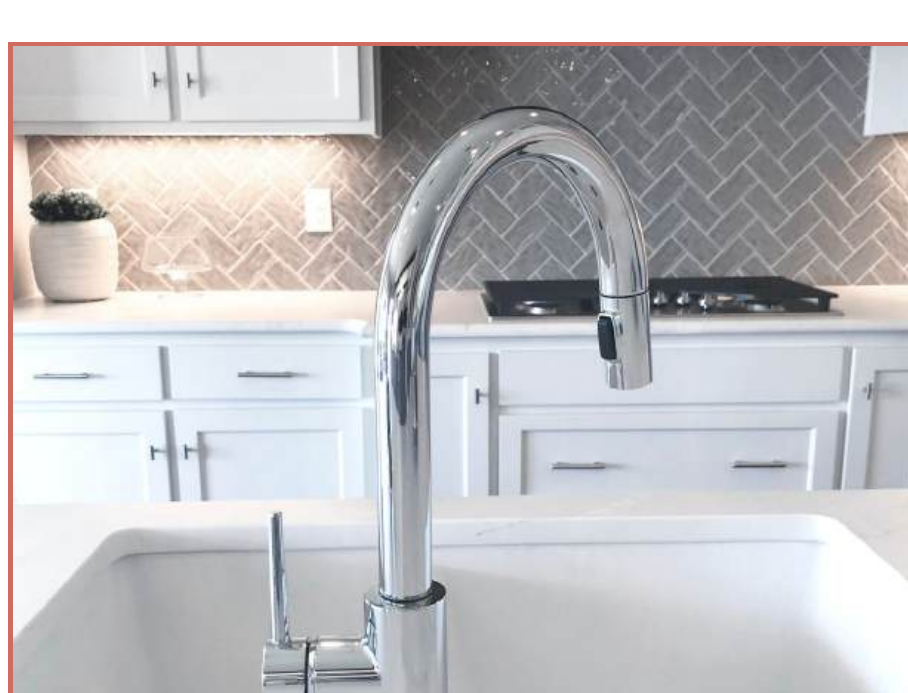
4. Wall Touch-Ups: Cosmetic Fixes That Make a Difference
